GENERAL CONDITIONS

INPP is the only agency that is commissioned by the French Ministry of Labour to conduct professional multidisciplinary training courses for all categories of personnel working in conditions of pressure higher than atmospheric pressure. INPP provides its expertise in that field to all French Ministries and acts as adviser in subaquatic and hyperbaric operations.

TRAINING COURSES

<p>ARTICLE 1 - COMING INTO FORCE OF THE CONTRACT The approval by the customer of INPP's commercial offers appended with these herewith General Conditions, implies the coming into force of the contract.</p> <p>ARTICLE 2 - VALIDITY OF OFFERS Unless it is stipulated otherwise, INPP's offers are valid for sixty days.</p> <p>ARTICLE 3 - ORGANISATION OF THE COURSES The different categories of courses are outlined in the basic programme. Within the general frame of this programme, INPP is free to reorganise the courses when faced with unexpected contingencies.</p> <p>ARTICLE 4 - ADMISSION TO THE COURSES Only applicants accepted by INPP's Entrance Selection Committee will be eligible for training.</p> <p>ARTICLE 5 - CONFERRING OF DIPLOMAS Those trainees that have followed and completed training successfully will receive a Certificate of Attendance and will be conferred the corresponding diploma.</p> <p>ARTICLE 6 - INTERRUPTION IN THE TRAINING 6.1 - An interruption in the training may be the result of : n medical unfitness, n inability to follow the course, n disciplinary measure.</p> <p>6.2 - In the first two cases, the cost for the training will be reduced proportionately with the number of days of training. In the case of a disciplinary measure, the cost of training will have to be paid in full.</p> <p>6.3 - When the trainee himself or his employer are responsible for the interruption, the cost of the training will have to be paid in full.</p> <p>ARTICLE 7 - UNFORESEEN CIRCUMSTANCES In case of unforeseen and uncontrollable circumstances, INPP pledges to take the necessary steps for conferring the qualification.</p>	<p>ARTICLE 8 - LIABILITY 8.1 - INPP covers damage that may be sustained by the trainees. For amounts exceeding this coverage, the trainee or his employer agree to renounce making any claim against INPP.</p> <p>8.2 - The present clause does not apply in the case of a trainee's gross or intentional misdemeanour.</p> <p>ARTICLE 9 - TERMS OF PAYMENT 9.1 - Payment is made in two instalments : n 30% at registration, n the remainder at the beginning of the training courses.</p> <p>9.2 - For services concerning control, evaluation, assistance and council, it may be specified in the contract that payments will be made : n as advance payment for operations preparatory to the execution of the contract, n as down payment during the execution of the contract for the services performed, n as balance payment in accordance with invoices presented by INPP.</p> <p>ARTICLE 10 - CONDITIONS OF PAYMENT 10.1 - When the contracts specifies an advance payment, operations will start only after this advance payment has been received.</p> <p>10.2 - When the contract specifies a down payment to be made during the execution of the contract, and when this down payment is one month overdue, the services will be discontinued.</p> <p>ARTICLE 11 - DEPOSIT Upon their arrival for the course, each trainee will have to pay a deposit of 150 Euros (One hundred and fifty Euros intended to cover eventual damage or loss of equipment entrusted to his care (bag and individual equipment, room in living quarters, etc...)).</p> <p>ARTICLE 12 - ARBITRATION Disputes that may arise during the performance of services by INPP, will be submitted to the competent regional judicial authority.</p>
